Our Learning

Language Arts

This month we will work on the seventh and final group of letter sounds (qu, ou, oi, ue, er, and ar). In our small groups as well as whole group we will work more on concepts of print, tracking print/pointing to words when we read, we will do some interactive writing, and independent journal writing. We will finish our talking tables unit on baby animals.

Math

In math we are still working on representing numbers in many ways. Students are encouraged to show numbers on ten frames, with tallies, with number sentences, number bonds, pictures, words, numerals, and any other way we have learned.

Science

We have been talking about Force and Motion and how things move. We will also learn about rainbows and colour. We will do some rainbow experiments and how rainbows are made.

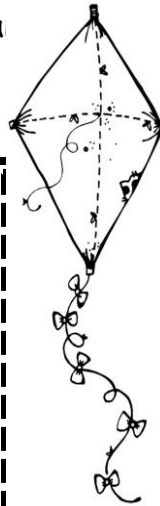
Upcoming Events
